LT. GOVERNOR TO APPEAR ON “DAVIS COUNTY NOW”

DAVIS COUNTY – Utah's Lieutenant Governor, Gary Herbert, will appear on Davis Cable 17 to discuss the Legacy Highway and other Davis County transportation issues. In particular, Herbert will be talking about the state-level efforts to move the Legacy Highway project ahead.

Herbert will appear on an episode of the locally-produced “Davis County Now” premiering the week of December 12, 2005.

“It was a great honor for us to have the Lieutenant Governor,” said host Kevin Cummings. “I think it shows how much interest the Governor's office has in the transportation challenges facing Utah.”

In addition to the Lieutenant Governor, the program will feature two of the local leaders who helped shape the deal. County Commissioner Dannie McConkie will talk about the details of the Legacy agreement. State Senator Sheldon Killpack will share the legislative perspective on the roadway and talk about the future of the project.

David Creer, Executive Director of the Utah Trucking Association, will respond to the agreement from the point-of-view of Trucking Association members.

Station Manager, J. Scott Iverson, noted that this program is yet another in Davis Cable 17's ongoing effort to keep the public informed on issues of critical importance to County residents. “In addition to this episode, ‘Davis County Now’ has recently aired four mayoral election specials and a Farmington *Meet the Candidates Night*.” Other upcoming episodes will cover such subjects as Davis County Disaster Preparedness, Multi-culturalism in Davis County, and State Senators Greg Bell and Sheldon Killpack.
